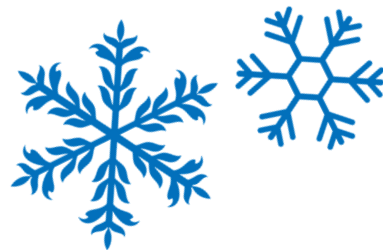




Examining Snowflakes

Supplies:

Black Construction Paper (or anything black, fabric, cardboard, etc.)

Magnifying Glass



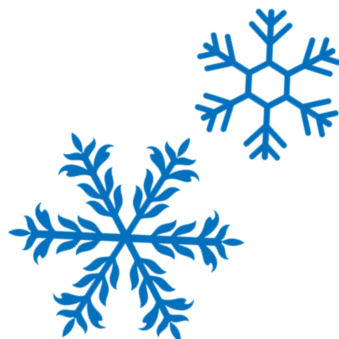
Directions:

1. Place black paper in freezer for a 2-3 hours.
2. Take frozen paper outside when it is snowing.
3. Catch snowflakes on the paper.
4. Use the magnifying glass to observe the different snowflake patterns.



What is happening?

This experiment allows you to see snowflakes up close and personal and the frozen black paper helps you observe them longer.
